Our respected faculties divulged us a lot of information, we were also lucky to observe the 'Neela Kurunji' (Strobilanthes kunthiana), the one which flowers once in 12 years. The caretaker showed us the guest house of that place from where we were able to have a good view of the whole cholayil land. The caretaker lead us to further places where we could observe the farming methods. There were plantations of Beans, Okra, Amalaki, Sapodilla, Mango; etc.

We also observed the compost pits, manures, etc. There were specific green shades for rare plants like cactus. Apart from these we had a glimpse of Emu, hens and rabbits. We departed from garden around 2:00 pm and were inside the campus of SJSACH, Nazarathpet around 4:00pm in the evening.

It was a valuable and fun filled journey all way. The faculties showered their better and the students gained the best of knowledge.
