

FREE SCREENING MEDICAL CAMP FOR FEMALE WORKERS

was conducted at PG Department of Prasuti Tantra & Stree Roga of Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Ayurveda College & Hospital organized a free screening Ayurveda medical camp on June 15 2024 for female workers of nearby factories. The camp was conducted during the post lunch section from 3 PM to 05:30 PM. It was supervised and consulted by Prof. Dr L.V. Rathnakar., Head of Department, Dr. Swathi C, Associate Professor, Dr. Leela, Associate Professor, and Dr. Amrutha B.S., Assistant Professor along with Postgraduate scholars.

30 patients got benefited out of this free medical camp. Registration and consultations were provided free of cost to the patients. Comprehensive health screenings were conducted to assess the general health, reproductive health, and common gynaecological issues. Patients presented with complaints of urinary tract infection, leucorrhoea, infertility, PCOS, and various menstrual disorders were benefited from the camp.

It was a significant step by the Institute towards improving the health and well-being of female factory workers. By offering free check-ups and consultations, the camp successfully addressed a critical gap in healthcare access for this demographic. The initiative not only provided immediate medical attention but also empowered women with knowledge about their health, thereby fostering a culture of preventive care.
